Cub Scout Pack 794 General Information – 2013-2014

Welcome to Cub Scout Pack 794, chartered by Mission Hills Church! We are a Christian Pack, and have been part of the church for over 20 years. We are glad to have you and your son be a part of our Pack and look forward to experiencing the adventure of Cub Scouting together.

Meetings

We meet three Thursday nights a month, at 7:00 PM, usually on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Thursday of each month. Two of these are Den meetings, and one is a Pack meeting. Refer to the Calendar for details.

Organization

The Pack is divided up into Dens by age level. Each Den is lead by an adult Den Leader.

- Tigers are First Grade, and are accompanied by at least one parent
- Wolves are Second Grade
- Bears are Third Grade
- Webelos 1 are Fourth Grade and Webelos 2 are Fifth Grade

Upon completing Webelos, your Scout can join a Boy Scout Troop to continue with Scouting. Mission Hills Church also charters Troop 794, but you can join any troop you would like.

Activities

At the beginning of the year, we have our annual Popcorn Sale fundraiser. This is our only fundraiser for the year, and is used to fund our activities. During the year, we will have a Raingutter Regatta boat race, Pinewood Derby car race, the Blue and Gold Banquet, Service Projects, and more. In addition, at the Den meetings, different activities will be done that are related to rank advancement. These are listed in your Cub Scout's manual.

Camping Opportunities

There are a few camping opportunities for Cub Scouts during the Summer.

- In late June, there is the Arapahoe District Day Camp, held at a local park. The cost for this will be ~\$50/scout, and registration is online
- In June and July, there is Magness Summer Camp, which is at Peaceful Valley Scout Ranch near Elbert, CO. Magness is a three-day, two night camping experience for Cub Scouts and their parent. Siblings can attend too. The cost for this will be ~\$100/scout and ~\$80/parent.
- In September, our Pack has a Family Campout at a Chatfield State Park. The cost for this will be ~\$40/family.
